Remarks Tuesday 3rd October 1837

Fine Weather and Moderate breezes throughout
this day trim'd a go for oil and Lundry
small jobs.

Wednesday 4th

Cloudy Weather throughout this day.

Shooka 100 Gall. cask and remade it
for oil Broacha beef & Pork.

Thursday 5th

This morning light airs and Cloudy at 10
o'clock for Blackfish Starboard boat took
a small one trim'd two barrells for oil and
Repaired the Span yarn Winch.

Friday 6th

This morning thick hazy weather a sail in
sight off the Weather beam at 10 o'clock
Spoke the Ship Henry of Nantucket 500.

Barrells, Gamia with her Exchange a Bunde
of light 3rd for heavy 3rd Iron hoops.

Saturday 7th

Moderate breeze and Cloudy Weather
throughout this day trim'd a Water cask
for oil and various small jobs.
