Friday 3rd
First and middle part of this day cloudy
latter clear and fine weather broach'd a
barrell of Pork.

Saturday 4th
Strong breezes attended with squalls
throughout this day.

Sunday 5th
This morning double reef'd the Fore
and single reef'd the main and mezen
Topsails, Strong gales throughout the day
attended with hard squalls at intervals
at sun set double reef'd the main topsail
took in the Spanker and jib.

Remarks Monday 6th November 1837.
Strong Gales attended with hard
squalls throughout this day
Tuesday 7th

Strong gales and clear weather
throughout this day Employ'd making
Ries of a small size
Wednesday 8th

Fine pleasant weather the most part
of this day Employ'd as yesterday broach'd
a barrell of beef.

Thursday 9th
First and middle part cloudy latter
clear and pleasant weather trimd two
cask for oil one that contain'd Slops
and one Water cask.

Friday 10th
Fine clear weather and strong breezes
throughout this day Employ'd making
Ries.

Saturday 11th
Strong breezes and a heavy swell
throughout this day Employ'd as yesterday
Sunday 12th

First part cloudy, middle and latter
clear weather and strong breezes.
