and clear weather Employ'd making rics
Tuesday 14th

Fine moderate Weather throughout
this day at 5 O'clock lowered for blackfish
no Success. Employ'd as Yesterday,

Wednesday 15th
Moderate weather throughout this day
Finish'd making rics for the present
made nine Altogether,

Thursday 16th
Moderate and cloudy the most part
of this day trim'd two Water 60 for oil,

Friday 17th
Fine pleasant Weather throughout this
day At 4 O'clock lowered for Whales
no Success.

Saturday 18th
This morning fine Moderate weather
at 9 O'clock saw Whales to windward
of us At 1 O'clock lowered Starboard
boat took one at 5 O'clock lowered again
no Success Latter part Strong breezes-

Remarks Sunday 19th November 1837-
At day light wore ship and commenced
cutting Strong breezes and a heavy swell
at 11 O'clock commenced boiling mudd
and Latter part more Moderate,

Monday 20th
Moderate and cloudy weather throughout
this day at 2 O'clock lowered for Whales
no Success.

Tuesday 21st
This morning at day light finish'd boiling
at noon lowered for Whales the Larboard
boat took one at 3 O'clock commenced
cutting, Fine moderate Weather throughout
this day,

Wednesday 22nd
This morning fine moderate ^{weather} finish'd cutting
at noon and commenced boiling set up
one sap drawn 60 for oil mark'd R. M. 7.

Thursday 23rd
First and Middle part of this day nearly calm
latter gentle breezes Started six 60 of Flour
and trim'd them for oil and one 40 sack
back that contain'd sails,

Friday 24th
Light airs throughout this day at 11 O'clock
Finish'd boiling Wet hold and cleared off Sicks-
