

Remarks Tuesday 12th December 1837.

This day started two 60 of Flour and trimmed them for oil set up three Shooks marked C, Nos 22, 23, 27. and filled one of L. Shook Cask that contained Water this night at 11 O'clock finished boiling.

Wednesday 13th

This morning cleared off and washed Hecks not one Cask of any kind fitted for oil, at noon commenced setting up Shooks set up one No 29 at 4 O'clock saw Whales off the lee bow lower, the Starboard boat took one the Waste boat fastened and the line parted.

Thursday 14th

This morning commenced buting at 3 O'clock commenced boiling this day set up six Shooks marked C. Nos 25, 18, 19, 15, 16, 17. for oil.

Friday 15th

This day boiling set up three Shooks of the mark, C. Nos 21, 24, 26. and trimmed the Cask that contained the Heads for oil.

Remarks Saturday 16th Dec^r 1837.

This day Employ'd setting up two Shooks of the mark J. No 8, 210, = 9, 212 Gall^{ns} and trimmed one of the above mark that contained fresh Water the sap in this some little decay'd.

Sunday 17th

At 8 O'clock this Morning saw Whales off the lee bow lower for them the Waste boat fastened and hauled from him chased until noon but no success. At 5 O'clock in the Afternoon saw Whales lower again the Starboard boat fastened and lost his Line.

Monday 18th

This morning at daylight commenced breaking out in the Fore hold for a slow down, at 6 O'clock saw a Whale off the lee quarter the Starboard boat fastened got badly stove but saved the the Whale with the assistance of the other boats.

Tuesday 19th

This day finished buting in and commenced boiling started two 60 of Corn and one Cask of Bread fitted them for oil.
