This day Commences with fine Weather
and gentle breezes from East bound
South Middle part Steady breezes
at 6 a. m. broke out in the main
hatch for water on the Larboard side
Latter part fine clear Weather

Latitude at noon 8.48

Longitude 24.27

Tuesday 14th

This day begins with fine Clear Weather
Winds from E. N. E. bound South Middle
part fine at 8 A. M. Spoke a Barque
from Liverpool left 9th Nov^r

Latter part fine gentle breezes and Clear
Weather.

Latitude at noon 6.31 N

Longitude 23.53 W.

Wednesday 15th
Fine Moderate Weather the first of this
day at 7 P. M. took in all light sail
Middle part light air and Variable
at 7 A. M. spoke a ship bound to
Bristol did not ascertain her name
at 10 Spoke the ship Unicorn of
Salem, 26 Days from Boston bound
to Manilla, Steering S by W. there
24 hours. Lat 4.31 N.

Remarks Thursday 16th Dec^r 1841

This day Commences with light air and
cloudy Middle and Latter part light
air and Variable, Lat 4.10 N.

Friday 17th

First part of this day Moderate
Winds Variable at 4 P. M. Tack'd
Ship headed South westerly, Middle
and Latter part Squally and heavy
Showers of Rain, Latitude 3.15 N.

Saturday 18th

First part of this day light breezes
and Variable Rain at Intervals
Middle and Latter part light breezes,

Latitude 2.23 N.

Sunday 19th

This day Commences with light from
S. E. Variable headed S. W. westerly Longitude
7. Lunar at 4 P. M. 23.50 W. broach'd beef
and Pork, a Ship in sight Astern of us
Middle part light breezes attended with
Showers of Rain, Latter part breezes
light and variable a Ship off the bow
