 Putting heads into junk cask finished
 boiling at 6 a.m. the Whale made 90 lbs
 spoke the Cadmus of F. Haven, clear,
 thick Foggy Weather. Lat at noon 34.25 N
 Long. W. Cors. 45. 17 W.

Saturday 15th
 First part of this day calm and clear
 Weather at 6 A.M. took out the Harbours
 side main hold filled 5 of the shifting
 board cask with oil 52 lbs. drove 3 casks
 of Bread found them quite slack.
 No Obs.

Sunday 16th
 Moderate Weather stowed Empty cask and
 wood &c. off deck and washed off at 6 P.M.
 wore ship stood to the Northward & Westward
 under easy sail damp Foggy Weather
 Middle and Latter moderate and cloudy
 Latitude at noon 34.53 N
 Longitude 46. 12 W.

Remarks Monday 17th Jan^y. 1842
 Light breezes from N.E. and Cloudy
 at 7 P.M. Doubt reef'd the Topsails
 Furled Gib and mainsail, at 6 A.M.
 Commenced repairing the Fresh water that
 was taken out of the hold on Saturday.
 Shook a new 114 Gall. cask remade it put
 new heads in it gaged 104 Gall^{ns}
 No Obs.

Tuesday 18th
 First part of this day Moderate and
 Foggy at Intervals at 7 P.M. Shortened
 sail wore ship headed N.W. by W.
 Middle part an Increasing breeze at 5 A.M.
 broke out the Larboard side the main hold
 and run down the Remainder of the oil
 of Deck Latter part Strong breezes.
 No Obs.

Wednesday 19th
 This day Commences with Strong breezes
 finished stowing off at 3 P.M. and
 washed off Middle part strong breezes
 Latter Moderate and thickazy Weather
 This day put two new heads into a 270 Gall.
 cask one of the Ground Tier,
 Latitude 34. 50 N
