Showers of rain out 1<sup>st</sup> Reef Fore and  
main. Topsails at 10 P.M. out reef main  
topsail set Gib and Mainsail at 1 A.M.  
out Reef Fore and Mizzen topsails at daylight  
set the main top Gallant sail. Latter part  
Fine Steady Weather Latitude 43. 35 S.  
Longitude 49. 01 W.

Friday 28<sup>th</sup>  
First part fine Weather broke out in  
main hold for water, Middle part light  
airs from West Southerly and thick foggy  
Weather Latter part an Increasing breeze  
from the Northward course S.W. by W.

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> Latitude 44. 20 S.  
First part of this day fine breeze, and hazy  
Weather Middle part Strong breezes made  
S.W. by W. at 3 A.M. single Reef Fore  
and Mizzen topsails at 6 am out Reef Fore  
topsail set main top Gallant sail.  
Latter part Moderate Weather  
Latitude 45. 26 S.

P.M. Double reef topsails at 5 P.M.  
the main sail close reef mizen topsail  
Middle part rainy Weather at 5 A.M.  
bore ship headed W. by N. Latter fine  
Weather, Longitude of Lunar at 7 A.M.  
51. 36 W. Latitude at noon 45. 59 S.  
Monday 31<sup>st</sup>

This day commences with fine  
Moderate Weather at 3 P.M. Spoke the  
Ship Cortex of N. Beaufort bound home  
2300 lbs. 45 Months out at 4 P.M. an  
Increasing breeze from N.W. Double  
Reef topsails at 6 P.M. took in the Gib  
headed the mainsail at 9 P.M. Furled  
Fore and mizen topsails close reef the main  
Strong gales untill day light at 8 A.M.  
made sail Latter part moderate Weather  
headed South Easterly Latitude 46. 41 S.

Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> Feb<sup>y</sup>  
Moderate and thick hazy Weather at 2  
P.M. Tack'd ship headed W. by S. at 5 P.M.  
caught a Porpoise Middle part fine Moderate  
Weather at 4 am. Tack'd ship headed  
S.E. Latter Strong breezes and clear. Lat 46. 47 S.  
Long. of Lunar 52. 45 W.
