distance 40 Miles,

Friday, 25th

Strong breezes attended with rain and
Fog, saw Blackfish, at sun set shortened sail
to a close Reef. main top sail and Fore sail

Saturday, 26th

Strong gales and Rain the first part
at 4 O'clock the Weather moderate made
sail, Mapafuero bore North Distance 30 Miles

Sunday, 27th

Cloudy, the most part of this day at
noon Midway between Mapafuero and Juan.
Saw two Ships Pass to the Eastward of us.

Monday, 28th

This day trim'd the fresh Water Butt and
put it between Decks, this Afternoon saw
a Ship to leeward of us heaved in shore
light breezes and fine Weather,

Tuesday, 29th

This morning, broke out in the Fore and
main hatches for Water fill'd the new Butt.
shook'd the old one and two oil Cask mark'd
D, No 6 & 7. at 3 O'clock saw Whales lower'd
(no Success).

Longitude of Lunar 75. 46 W.

Cloudy the most part of this day
Boraqua bay & Fork Latitude 24. 12

Tuesday 5th

Cloudy the most part of this day, and
moderate breezes. at 4 O'clock saw the Land
bore E by N from us by Compas. Lat 23. 34
