

Remarks Friday 28th May 1842 -
This morning saw a sail ahead of us off
the Weather bay at noon sent two boats
ashore for Tarpin at sun set came off with
one dead.

Saturday 29th
This morning two boats went ashore came off to
the Ship at 5 O'clock with four two of them
alive.

Sunday 30th
This day off Harbrough spoke the ship
Martha of T. Harren 7 Months out 40 bls. and
the Ship R. Edwards & M. out 500. three
others in sight.

Monday 31st
This Morning six sail in sight all headed
in for Harbrough Latitude at noon 0 - 49 S -
Longitude of Lunar 91. 36 30 W

Tuesday 1st
This Morning off the Weather bay remade one
Rin, Latitude at noon 1. 49 S

Wednesday 1st June Longitude 91. 44 -
This Morning off Harbrough remade one rin
four sail in sight, brack'a bay & Fork,

Remarks Thursday 2nd June 1842 -
This Morning one ship in sight the Martha
Nearly calm all day North head on E by S -
Latitude at noon 11 miles North, trimed two
barrels for oil,

Friday 3rd
This day made a draw Bucket
six sail in sight Latitude at noon 1. 42 N.
Longitude of Lunar 92. 24 W.

Saturday 4th
This day spoke the Barque Cora of N Bedford
9 Months out 120 Barrels. Winmans Soland on
E by N from us. at noon.

Sunday 5th
This day nearly calm two sail in sight
Monday 6th Lat at noon 1. 19 N

This day remade one rin Harbours boat
went fishing to winmans Soland caught half
a boat load, spoke the ship Boy of Warren,
25 Months out 100 bls. Lat 1. 14 N.

Tuesday 7th
This day broke out for Water trimed one
barrel for black fish oil spoke the Hero
of Anturket 9 Months out 70 bls. Lat. 01. 56 N
