This Morning cut in the Whale and
commenced boiling, Latitude at noon - 26 N.

Thursday 7th
This Morning finished boiling and washed
off decks. Latitude " 31-

Friday 8th
Strong breeze and clear Weather
Broke out in the Fore hold for Water
Proach'd reef and Lark Lat Meridian

Saturday 9th
Strong gales throughout this day & rattle
up the Top sails.

Sunday 10th
This Morning at 10 o'clock spoke the
Ship Phoenix of Nantucket two years out
1350 bbls. Lat Equator.

Monday 11th
This Morning three sail in sight to leeward
we trim'd our Water cask 183 Gall^{ns}.

Tuesday 12th
Moderate and Clear Weather this day
Lat at noon 00. 43. N
Longitude φ Lunar 132. 44. 15 W

Thursday 14th
Fair Weather throughout this day
Latitude at noon 01. 28. N
Longitude at 2 o'clock φ Lunar 136. 27. 20 W

Friday 15th
Fine Weather the most part of this day
Latitude at noon 15. N

Saturday 16th Longitude φ Lunar 138. 38 W

This Morning, broke out in the main
hold and stowed about 35 bbls. of oil on
the Larboard side and took up down Water
cask to Repair Latitude 18 Miles N

Sunday 17th
Fine Moderate Weather this day
Latitude at noon Equator

Monday 18th Long. 142. 45. 15 W

Fine Pleasant Weather, this morning
set the Fore topmast Studding sail
Trim'd three of the Foremast two cask for oil
Latitude at noon 00. 2 S
