Fine moderate Weather steering to the
Westward trim'd two of the Ground Casks
for oil Lat at noon 0. 6 N.

Thursday 21st

This day trim'd two of the Ground keel Casks
for oil Latitude at noon 1. 11 N.

Friday 22nd

This morning at 8 O'clock saw Christmas
Island at 3 O'clock the Harbour boat went
on shore in search of Turtle did not get any

Saturday 23rd

This Morning came off to ship, stood to
the South West

Sunday 24th

Fine weather the most part of this day
Latitude at noon 0. 5, South at 3 O'clock
saw Whales the Harbour boat took one
brought him along side and took Whale
and fluke Chum

Monday 25th

Fine Weather saw Jarvis Island at
10 O'clock

Fine Pleasant Weather trim'd one
small Water for oil, Lat at noon 00. 8 N.

Thursday 28th

Fine Moderate weather, made one 10 Inch
Rice Lat at noon 00. 18. N.

Friday 29th

This day made one 10 Inch Rice fine
Moderate Weather, Lat at noon 00. 40. N.

Saturday 30th

Fine gentle Weather, this day the People
clean'd the Forecastle to destroy the Bugs.

Latitude at noon 00. 41 N.

Long of Lunar 166. 26 W.

Sunday 31st

Fine Weather throughout this day

Latitude at noon 00. 41

at 9 O'clock Long of Lunar 167. 40. W.

Monday 1st August

Fine clear Weather and light air.
