

Remarks Tuesday 2nd August 1842

Fine Weather and light breezes, made two
Ries. broad's key & Fork Lat 49 S.
Long of Lunar 170 20 W.

Wednesday 3rd

Fine Pleasant weather, made two Ries
Latitude at noon 16 S.
Long. of Lunar 172. 46 W.

Thursday 4th

Fine Weather and Moderate breeze Lat. - 7 W.

Friday 5th

This morning saw Whales toward the Star
board boat struck a small one the Larboard
boat fastened and hauled, Lat at noon 33 S.
Long of Chr. 175 10 W.

at 2 O'clock toward again the Waste boat
took one at 5 O'clock saw Whales off the
Starboard beam toward the Larboard boat
no Success.

Saturday 6th

at 8 O'clock saw Whales toward the Waste
boat took a large Whale Lat 55 S.

Sunday 7th

This day cut in the Whales and commenced
trying out, Lat at noon 41 S.

Remarks Monday 8th August 1842

This day all hands Employed trying out
Spoke the ship Otomac of Nantucket 9
Months out 300 bbl.

Tuesday 9th

This day finished boiling, Tapping Hoses
of Rins, and a heavy swell.

Wednesday 10th

Strong breezes this day Lat 34 S.
saw two sail to leeward of us.

Thursday 11th

This day Hove 70. bbl. of oil the
Starboard side main hold, and 11 Ries,
Strong breezes the most part of this day saw
a Sail off our Weather Quarter.

Friday 12th

Fine Pleasant Weather, trimmed one of
the Ground tur Cask Lat at noon 25 S.
Long. of Lunar 177. 38 W.

Saturday 13th

This day trimmed one of Ground tur Cask
Spoke the Ship Margaret Scott of
N. Bedford 19 Months out 300 bbl.
Lat 1. 08 S.
