Tuesday 13th Lat. at noon 4. 42 S-

This morning saw Whales toward the
Larboara boat took a small one,

Squally Weather the most part of this day

This day trimd a 283 Gall. cask, the
Weather more Moderate. Lat at noon 2. 56 S

This day made one Run try'd out the small
Whale made about 7 Bbls,

15 miles,

Thursday 22nd

This day made two Runs, fine Moderate
Weather Lat at noon 3. 8 S

Friday 23rd

Fine pleasant Weather at 3 o'clock close
in at Hope Island natives off to us
this day put the Land into bbls 4 1/2 bbls
of it

Saturday 24th

First part of the day fine Moderate Weather
 Latter Squally some Rain, Lat 2. 56
