Moderate Weather this day at 11 O'clock
saw Whales leeward the boats but no Success

Monday 26th Lat at noon 2. 51 South

First part of this day Strong breezes

Latter more Moderate at 2 O'clock Rotches
Island bore N.W. at 4 O'clock canoes alongside
saw Whales to leeward of us. leeward the
boats no Success remain on old River,

Tuesday 27th

This day on Shore at Rotches Island
trading for Cocoa nuts and Poultry,

Wednesday 28th

Fine Weather throughout this day.

Thursday 29th

Fine Moderate weather, E. made one River,

Friday 30th

Strong breezes the first part of this day
Latter more Moderate. Lat 3. 16 S.

Saturday 1st Oct^r Long 7^h Chro. 176. 00 E.

Fine Moderate weather throughout this day

Sunday 2nd

Calm all this day Lat 3. 34 S.

Remarks Monday 3rd October 1842

Calm all this day. this Morning commenced
Painting the Yards. at noon saw Whales
leeward the Harbour boat took a 20 bl.
Whale,

Tuesday 4th

This Morning cut in the Whale and commenced
boiling. Gentle breezes throughout this day.

Wednesday 5th

Fine breezes the most part of this day
made to the Eastward Lat 3. 38 S.

Thursday 6th

Fine pleasant Weather. broke out in the
Fore hold for Water. Coopers a 271 Gall
Cask & two Rivers to flow,

Friday 7th

This Morning stowed 40 bls. & two Rivers the
Harbour side main hold, at 3 O'clock
saw Whales leeward so Success

Lat at noon 4. 32 S

Saturday 8th Long 7^h Chro. 179. 00 E.

This day put a new head in a 188 Gall
Cask Shooked two old Rivers made one bone
River of them, at noon saw Whales breaching
to windward of us 10 or 12 miles off.

Lat at noon 4. 50 S
Long 7^h Lunar 179. 12 E.
