Fine weather and light air at 8 O'Clock saw Whales lowered no success Lat 10-55 S-

First part of this day Calm and very warm Made one 18th Run Latter part rainy,

Strong gales and squally at intervals trima a 238 Gall. Cask for oil

This day Strong gales attended with rain under close Reefs-

This morning weather more moderate Latter part strong gales and rain winds Northwily Lat at noon 6-13 S-
