This morning the Ship Monticello came in

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> Fine pleasant weather this day

Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup>

This day brought off three boats load of wood

Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> This day brought off three boats load of wood  
Shocks and pipes No 15 - badly rotten

Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> The Starboard Watch came on board  
and the Larboard watch went on Liberty,

Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> The Larboard Watch came on board  
the ship Columbia of Nantucket came in 14 Months ago.

Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> This morning the young Phoenix sailed  
afternoon the Barque Menacheta of London came in  
Took one pipe No 28 - 163 - Gall.

Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> This morning weighed anchor bound to the  
Northward on a course,

Friday 21<sup>st</sup> This day Steering North Lat 15. 53 N.

Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> Fine weather this day Lat at noon 17. 41 N.

Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> Fine moderate weather Lat 19. 44 N.

Monday 24<sup>th</sup> Fine weather this day Lat 21. 30 N.

Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> Fine moderate weather this day Steering  
to the Northward between the old Redden Butt  
and  
Lat at noon 22. 40 N.

Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> Fine moderate weather winds at south  
Lat at noon 23. 53 N.

Remarks Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April 1843.  
Fine weather the last part of this day Lat 24. 20 N.

Friday 28<sup>th</sup> Fine clear weather Lat 24. 56 N.

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> This morning some Rain latter part  
fine weather Steering NW. Lat 25. 06 N.

Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> Fine gentle weather this day Lat 25. 12 N.

Monday 1<sup>st</sup> May Moderate weather and cloudy at  
intervals some Rain spoke the Ship Monticello  
made one small Rise Lat at noon 25. 22 N.

Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> The first part of this day cloudy and a fresh breeze  
latter heavy Rain attended with thunder and lightning  
No obs.

Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> This day saw a ship to windward of us  
Lat at noon 26. 07 N.

Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> Strong breeze this day spoke the Monticello  
and saw a ship to leeward of us on a head  
Lat at noon 26. 38 N.

Friday 5<sup>th</sup> This morning close in with the Land  
one of the Bonin Islands Lat at noon 27. 00 N.

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> This day gentle breeze and clear  
weather a sail in sight to the Eastward of us  
Lat at noon 27. 30 N.

Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> Fine pleasant weather this day  
the sail in sight to the Eastward of us  
Lat at noon 28. 12 N.

Monday 8<sup>th</sup> Long if Lunar 141. 58 East  
First part of this day calm and cloudy  
latter fresh breeze with rain made one small rise  
No obs.

Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> Moderate weather this day and foggy  
at intervals saw the Rock, Lat at noon 29. 37 N.

Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> This morning at 9 O'clock passed a small  
Peak at 2 O'clock past St. Peter's Island,  
Lat at noon 30. 08 N.
