

Remarks Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June 1843 -

Strong breeze and cloudy the most part of the day, headed to the Northward Lat 30 40 N.

Saturday 10<sup>th</sup>  
This morning rain and thick fogg. the latter part more favourable Lat 30 40 N.

Sunday 11<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate and cloudy weather the most part of this day Lat at noon 30 29 N.

Monday 12<sup>th</sup>  
This day strong breeze and foggy the most part of the day Lat at noon 30 50 N.

Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup>  
Fine moderate weather this day Lat 30 42 N.

Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate and cloudy weather the most part of this day spoke the Barque Pearl of Lifford 17 months out 95 bls.

Thursday 15<sup>th</sup>  
Strong breeze and cloudy weather the most part of this day remade one old Lion.

Friday 16<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather this day spoke the Bermansay of London no sail on the left Port Lat at noon 29 28

Saturday 17<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day strong breeze and some rain at noon hove in the main topmast and fore mast latter strong gales and a heavy squall No bls.

Sunday 18<sup>th</sup>  
This day more moderate weather two sail in sight Lat at noon 30 42 N.

Monday 19<sup>th</sup>  
Fine pleasant weather this day Lat 30 23 N. Long Lunar 157 20 30 E.

Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather this day Lat at noon 29 55 Long Lunar 157 58 E.

Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup>  
Fine stronger breeze this day with some passing showers of rain Lat at noon 29 18 N.

Remarks Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June 1843 -

Moderate weather with passing showers of rain spoke the Bermansay Lat at noon 30 08 N.

Friday 23<sup>rd</sup>  
Strong breeze and smoky weather this day Lat 29 54 N.

Saturday 24<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day strong breeze with rain and fog Lat at noon 31 09 N.

Sunday 25<sup>th</sup>  
Favourable weather this day Lat 32 11 1/2 N.

Monday 26<sup>th</sup>  
This morning strong breeze and rain took in sail to a double reefed main topmast No bls.

Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup>  
Rain and thick weather the most part of this day Lat 32 11 1/2 N.

Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup>  
Squally at intervals and strong breeze Lat at noon 30 50 N.

Thursday 29<sup>th</sup>  
This morning at 10 o'clock saw a whale however no sail's favourable weather this day spoke the Ship Ann Alex 2 1/2 Reaped Lat at noon 30 37 N.

Friday 30<sup>th</sup>  
Strong breeze and a heavy squall this day Lat at noon 29 58 N.

Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> July  
Throughout this day strong gales with rain at intervals.

Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Strong gales and rain squalls at intervals this day.

Monday 3<sup>rd</sup>  
Strong breeze and cloudy the most part of this day Lat at noon 31 16 N.

Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup>  
Strong breeze and cloudy the first part of this day Lat 31 25 N.
