

Remarks Saturday 29th July 1843 -
Light air this day two sails in sight made one
12th R. R. Lat at noon 29. 30 N.

Sunday 30th

Fine gentle breeze this day a sail to leeward of us
Lat at noon 29. 42 N.

Long J. Luman at 2 O'clock 166. 17. 00 E.

Monday 31st

Fine weather this day made one 13th R. R.
two sail in sight this afternoon Lat at noon 30. 03 N.

Long J. Luman at 3 O'clock 167. 01 E.

Tuesday 1st August

Passing between of Rain the first part of this day
made one 12th R. R. spoke the Ship Foster of Newcastle
24 Months out 700 bbls. Lat at noon 29. 54 N.

Long J. Luman at 2 O'clock 168. 20 E.

Wednesday 2nd

Fine weather this day made one 13th R. R. spoke the
Barque Canton of New Bedford 700 bbls. Lat at noon 30. 16 N.

Long J. Luman at 2 O'clock 169. 38 E.

Thursday 3rd

Strong breeze this day and cloudy two sail in
sight made one 13th R. R.

Friday 4th

Strong breeze this day seven sail in sight made
one 13th R. R. at 6 past 6 O'clock saw a Whale spouting 4 Points
off the weather too supposed it to be a Sperm Whale Lat at noon 30. 54 N.

Saturday 5th

This morning four sail in sight, saw a Whale headed
to windward going South, did not follow, made one 11th R. R.
Lat at noon 30. 53 N.

Sunday 6th

This morning four sail in sight. Strong
breeze and thick weather. Lat at noon 30. 53 N.
Spoke the Ship Transit of Newcastle 1350.

Monday 7th

Moderate breeze the most part of this day four sail in sight.
this afternoon spoke the Ship Monitor of Newport 20 Months out
750 bbls. made one 11th R. R. Lat at noon 31. 01 N.

Tuesday 8th

This morning two sail in sight, made two 12th R. R.
Lat at noon 30. 30 N.

Wednesday 9th

Fine moderate weather two ships in sight
made two 13th R. R. spoke the Ship Nyctea Scott
of Newcastle 24 Months out 1000 bbls. Lat 30. 05 N.

Remarks Thursday 10th August 1843.

Fine moderate weather same two ships in sight,
made one 12th R. R. at 2 past 5 O'clock saw 11 whales
however no success. Lat at noon 29. 34 N.

Friday 11th

Fine weather this day made one 12th R. R.
two ships in sight.

Saturday 12th

This morning saw a Whale break to leeward
of us run for him but did not see anything more of him
see sail on sight spoke the Ship Cortes of N. Bedford
13 Months out 700 bbls. Lat at noon 29. 55 N.

Sunday 13th

Strong breeze this day saw three sails
Lat at noon 29. 43 N.

Monday 14th

Strong breeze and thick weather spoke the
Cortis, Lat 10 past 10 made one 10th R. R. Lat 30. 16
Long Monacan at 4 O'clock

Tuesday 15th

This morning saw Whales two Points off the weather
two more two boats no success fine weather this day
Lat at noon 30. 48 N.
Long J. Luman at 9 O'clock 179. 15 N.

Wednesday 16th

Fine strong breeze and clear weather made
one 13th R. R. Lat at noon 29. 50 N.

Thursday 17th

Strong breeze and a heavy swell this day
Lat at noon 29. 03 N.
Long J. Luman at 9 O'clock 179. 30 N.

Friday 18th

Strong breeze and Rain squalls throughout
this day made one small R. R. Lat 29. 32 N.

Saturday 19th

This morning saw Whales toward the North East
took a large one saw a Barque to windward of us
cutting fine weather this day.

Sunday 20th

This day at noon finished cutting fine moderate
weather.

Monday 21st

Fine gentle breeze and clear weather finished
boiling in the first watch made about 65 fath.
