Fine Weather this day Lat at noon 30. 28 N

Wednesday 23rd
This day Gaping showers of Rain, boisterous
& Rins of oil for Steaming

Thursday 24th
Fine Pleasant Weather Stowed 58 bbls of oil
the Starboard side four Sola took up four of the
Sifting board Cask two of them some rotten

Friday 25th
This day broke out in the after hatch
took up four of the Ground tier Cask above them
Stowed about 125 bbls oil Lat at noon 30. 26 N

Saturday 26th
Fine moderate Weather trim'd three Cask for oil
Lat at noon 30. 302 N

Sunday 27th
Fine Weather this day, Lat 30 39 N.

Monday 28th
Fine moderate weather stormy N.E.
repaired an oil Cask put four new pieces heading
on new Stave Lat at noon 31. 12 N

Tuesday 29th
Moderate and hazy Weather Repaired two of
the Ground tier Cask Lat at noon 32. 12 N

Wednesday 30th
This day Hook'd three pipes off 60, 61, 56. Fine
Weather this day, spoke the ship Edw^d Henry of
Kentucket 950 bbls saw the Ocean prop to windward of us

Thursday 31st
Fine moderate weather this day Lat 30 57. N
Long of Lunar at 2 o'clock 177. 12 N

Friday 1st Sept^r
Strong breeze this day at Eby L. head of South,
Lat at noon 29 41 N.
Long of Lunar at 3 o'clock 177. 21 N

Saturday 2nd
This day Hook'd two pipes. 125 62 & 63
Lat at noon 28 42 N.
Long of Lunar at 4 o'clock 176 50 45 N.

Sunday 3rd
This morning saw Whales between the Landward
boat struck one and lost him at 1 o'clock saw
Whales again between the Landward boat took a 60 bbls
Whale Lat at noon 28. 03 N

Remarks Monday 4th September 1843
This day Calm in the offing, commenced boiling
at 12 o'clock

Tuesday 5th
This day boiling, light airs and variable
Lat at noon 28. 50

Wednesday 6th
Light airs from the Eastward finished
boiling at 4 P.M. saw two sail, Lat at noon 28 52

Thursday 7th
Fine breeze, this day two sail in sight at
sun set spoke the ship Ganges of Portland 24
Months out 400 bbls. Lat at noon 29. 36 N.

Friday 8th
Fine moderate weather Stowed 7 Rins of oil for
Steaming spoke the Ganges, & Martha of Fairhaven 800 bbls.
Saw a Bird to seaward of us.

Saturday 9th
Fine gentle Weather, two sail in sight as yesterday
Spoke about 85 bbls of oil in the after hold.

Sunday 10th
Calm the most part of this day two ships in sight
Lat at noon 30 58 N.

Monday 11th
First part of this day light airs, latter
Calm. Martha & Ganges in sight to seaward of us.
Remained an old Rins, Lat at noon 30 57 N.

Tuesday 12th
Calm this day and very warm, at sun down
a strange sail in sight, made a Great Tub and trunks
a 60 for fresh Water, Lat at noon 30. 53 N.

Wednesday 13th
Calm the most part of this day two sail in
sight, put two Rins in a Skates go for oil
Lat at noon 30 55 N.

Thursday 14th
Fine breeze and clear Weather same two sail in sight
made a Rins out of a Finegar Rins, remained one old Rins
Lat at noon 30 33 N.
Long of Lunar at 9 o'clock 174. 28 N.

Friday 15th
Strong breeze this day a ship off our Weather
beam, made out 10 8th Rins Lat at noon 28. 58 N.
