

Remarks Saturday 16th September, 1843
Strong breeze with passing showers of rain, this morning
at 8 o'clock saw 3 small boats on the Larboara boats
took on 75 bl. Oil
Lat at noon 29 19 N

Sunday 17th
This day finishing cutting and commenced boiling
some passing showers of rain attended with strong
breezes,

Monday 18th
Fine moderate weather put two new pieces of heading
into a junk cask to fill with oil and trimmed a Board
cask for do-

Tuesday 19th
Fine weather finished boiling at 4 o'clock
this morning, set up two Shooks W, M and R, S.

Wednesday 20th
Moderate weather this day bropt a 7 Rows of oil
for stowing and 3 cask for stowing into
Lat at noon 31. 27 N

Thursday 21st
Fine weather and light breeze, a sail in sight
off the Master's Quarters, this day stowed 90 bl of oil
in the Fore hold,

Friday 22nd
Moderate weather this day, trim a 3 Water
cask for oil and one Board cask at sun set spoke
the ship Maudslayi of N. Beaford Lat at noon 31. 16 N

Saturday 23rd
Fine breeze and clear weather headed East, trim a
Water Cask for oil 153 gallons. Spoke the Maudslayi, 12 Months
out 400 bl.

Sunday 24th
Fine weather this day headed N.E. by E
Lat at noon 31. 13 N.

Monday 25th
Strong breeze from the S.E. this day set up two
Shooks for Water No 25-252, 25-286, Lat at noon 32. 09 N.

Tuesday 26th
This day strong breeze and a heavy swell set up
3 Shooks No 25-288, 25-281, 25-282 Lat at noon 32. 50 N.

Wednesday 27th
Fine moderate weather this day set up 4 Shooks
No 25-232, 25-258, 25-224, 25-282
Lat at noon 33. 14 N.

Remarks Thursday 28th September 1843
This day nearly calm set up two Shooks No 47-232
48-280, and Shook a two pipes No 57 & 59-

Friday 29th
Light air and clear weather this day set up
three Shooks No 45-226, 43-286, 42-239

Saturday 30th
Breeze the most part of this day some passing
showers of rain set up two Shooks No 4-256, 40-250,

Sunday 1st October
Light air and variable this day
Lat at noon 33. 05 N.
Long. Sp Lunar 3. 30 O'clock 156. 25 W.

Monday 2nd
Strong breeze this day from N.E. steering S by E.
Lat at noon 31. 58 N.

Tuesday 3rd
Strong breeze and squally steering S. E by E. Lat 30. 24 N

Wednesday 4th
Light air and variable Lat at noon 29. 02 N.

Thursday 5th
Fine weather this day wind southerly headed East.
Lat at noon 28. 35 N.

Friday 6th
Strong breeze this day wind southerly heading up
East Lat at noon 28. 15 N.

Saturday 7th
This morning two sail in sight wind East heading
up South variable Lat at noon 27. 55 N.

Sunday 8th
Most part of this day squally latter more steady
weather a ship to leeward of head the same as the
Lat at noon 27. 01 N.

Monday 9th
This day light air spoke the ship Midas of N. Beaford
17 Months out 2500 N. Lat at noon 26. 48

Tuesday 10th
Calm the most part of this day Lat. 25. 40 N.

Wednesday 11th
Strong breeze at North steering South Lat 24. 35 N.
Long. Sp. 153. 45 W.
