Thursday 9th
Strong breezes this day Lat at noon 14.24 N.

Friday 10th
Fine Moderate weather this day,
heading up S.E. by S. Lat at noon 13.11 N.
Long of Obs. 158.7. W.

Saturday 11th
Strong breezes and a heavy swell heading
up S.E. by S. Lat at noon 11.55 N.

Sunday 12th
Strong gales and a heavy swell under
short sail the last of these 24 hours.
Lat at noon 11.08 N.

Monday 13th
Strong gales and Rain squalls at intervals
Lat at noon 10.28 N.

Tuesday 14th
This day Weather more Moderate with Rain
Lat at noon 9.08 N.

Wednesday 15th
This day. Passing showers of Rain heading up
S.E. saw a Ship pop. to windward of us, steering
South. W. by S.

Thursday 16th
This day Moderate and Clear Weather steering
S.W. Wind N.E. North by East, Lat at noon 6.32 N.

Friday 17th
Moderate Weather this day and Rain on
the latter part Lat at noon 5.01 N.

Saturday 18th
Fine Moderate weather this day, the boy catches
his meals in the Stewage

Sunday 19th
Fine Moderate weather this day at noon saw
Whales near the Starboard and Larboard boats
the Starboard boat took two female ones the Larboard
one do. Lat at noon 3.47 N.

Monday 20th
This day cut in the Whales and commenced boiling
Rain at intervals,

Remarks Tuesday 21st Nov^r 1843-
This day boiling, strong passing showers rain
saw a ship pop. to windward of us standing to the
S.E.

Wednesday 22nd
at 4 O'clock this morning finished boiling
about 55 lbs. Fine Moderate weather,

Thursday 23rd
This day trimmed two 90 for oil and
set up one short mark W. & N.

Friday 24th
This morning commenced stowing the Starboard
sail for sale at 9 O'clock saw a dead Whale
hauled for him took him along side cut it in,

Saturday 25th
This morning stowing oil saw Whales this
forenoon towed Starboard & Larboard boats Larboard
boat struck lost his line Starboard boat took a
small one, Lat at noon 3.41 N.

Sunday 26th
This morning cut in the Whale and commenced
boiling

Monday 27th
This morning finished boiling mutton about 27 lbs
set up one 70 Gall. cask trimmed 4 bread cask for
oil

Tuesday 28th
This day trimmed a 90 that contained Potatoes
and one 70 Gall. cask

Wednesday 29th
This day set up one short mark W. & N. and
trimmed three 90s for oil,
Lat at noon 4.00 N.
Long of Obs. 156.50 W.

Thursday 30th
This day trimmed three 90s and one 60 for oil
Lat at noon 3.47 N.

Friday 1st Dec^r
This day trimmed two 90s for oil at noon saw
Whales towed each boat took one took them
along side and cut one in, Lat at noon 3.31 N.

Saturday 2nd
This morning finished cutting Rain at intervals
throughout the day.
