

Remarks Sunday 5th Decr. 1843

This morning commenced boiling some packing
shown of Rain through the day at 12 o'clock
Law Males covered the Larboard & Starboard
took one each.

Monday 6th

This morning finished boiling. Squally
the most part of the forenoon, cut in in the two
Males in the afternoon and commenced boiling.

Tuesday 7th

This day calm and Rain the most part
boiling between showers.

Wednesday 8th

First part of this day Rain, attended with
light breeze. Afternoon boila out the head,
made about 35 bbls.

Thursday 9th

This morning started a cask of Lept. & 2 Hops
trima the cask for oil put a new head in a gun
cask, set up R. No 7 Shook for oil, Lat 4. 43 N.

Friday 10th

This morning started a cask of Flour, trima
it for oil, set up one Water cask Shook
No 11 mark W, Cooper & Rins for stowing.

Saturday 11th

This day stowing bit in the Fore Peak.

Sunday 12th

This day finished stowing the oil at 2
o'clock, 90 bbls. Lat. 3. 38 N.

Monday 13th

This day trima 4 small Dry Cask and one
Trunk Miller cask for oil, Lat 3. 39 N.

Tuesday 14th

First part of this day Rain Later Dry Weather
Set up one Shook No 11

Wednesday 15th

Light squalls of Rain and strong breeze
throughout the day.

Thursday 16th

Strong gales at intervals attended with Rain
and a heavy swell remade one Water cask
Shook 267 Gallons reduced to 200 Gallons.

Remarks Friday 15th Decr. 1843

Strong gales this day saw a ship pass to leeward of us
headed to the southward made one W. M. Rins out of
Iron on the Stars Shook a two old Rins remade one
of them and trima one old Rins.

Saturday 16th

This day the Weather more Moderate remade
one old Rins.

Sunday 17th

Fine Weather this day, Lat at noon 3. 45 N
Long of Lunar 10 o'clock 158. 22 W.

Monday 18th

This day set up one Water cask Shook No 11
and trima one Water cask for oil, fine Moderate
Weather throughout this day.

Tuesday 19th

Moderate Weather and a heavy swell
remade one old Rins, Lat at noon 3. 30 N.

Wednesday 20th

This day remade three Rins Moderate
Weather made to the Eastward.

Thursday 21st

This day passing showers of Rain, remade
one Rins.

Friday 22nd

Fine clear Weather this day remade two
old Rins, Lat at noon 3. 53 N.

Saturday 23rd

Light squalls this day remade two old Rins
Lat at noon 5. 5

Sunday 24th

Strong breeze and Cloudy Weather
Lat at noon 4. 43 N.

Monday 25th

Moderate Weather with passing showers of
Rain at intervals, Lat at noon 3. 58 N
Long of Lunar at 3 o'clock 157. 48 W.

Tuesday 26th

First part of this thick Rainy Weather Later
Clean, Lat of Mer. alt. of Moon 3. 12 N.
Long of Lunar at 3 o'clock 158. 30 W.

Wednesday 27th

Fine Weather this day remade two old Rins
Lat at noon 3. 4 N
Long of Lunar at 2 o'clock 158. 55 W.
