Fine Moderate weather at 8 O'clock saw Wood's and
Henderson's Island natives came on board Lat - 8 N

Light airs throughout this day saw a sail
to the Eastward of us Lat at noon 27 S

Sunday 4th

Fine Moderate weather this day Lat at noon 1. 03 S

Monday 5th

This morning saw a sail to the Eastward of us -
Light airs the most part of this day Lat at noon 1. 30 S

Tuesday 6th

Fine Weather this day Lat at noon 1. 55 S

Wednesday 7th

Passing showers at Intervals throughout this day
Lat at noon 1. 18 S

Remarks Thursday 8th February 1844

Calm the most part of this day Lat at noon 5 S

Friday 9th

Passing showers of Rain this day at 3 O'clock
in at Ocean Island the natives came on board spoke
the Barque Ramon of Newport 15 Months out 40 tons

Saturday 10th

Fine Weather this day Lat at noon 16 S

Sunday 11th

This morning came with the Barque
Ramon Passing Ram's Head at Intervals

Lat at noon 48 S

Monday 12th Long 7 Lunar at 9 O'clock 168 28 E

Strong breezes and a heavy swell in the
afternoon saw the Barque standing to the Westward

Lat at noon 7 S

Tuesday 13th Long 7 Lunar at 10 O'clock 167. 50 E

Cloudy Weather and some Rain No. 10

Wednesday 14th

Thick rainy Weather this day No. 10

Thursday 15th

First and latter part of this day
plenty of rain saw a Barque this afternoon

Friday 16th

Fine Weather this day Lat 1. 53 S

Saturday 17th

Rain the most part of this day

Sunday 18th

Rain the most part of this day No. 10

Monday 19th

Fine Moderate weather this day
broke out in the afternoon for a cask shook heads
put down a cask of heads & spoons marked 576. 63 -
Shook 6 pipes Lat at noon 3. 14 N

Tuesday 20th

Fine Weather this day, commenced
setting up shooks for Water No. 25. 290 24. 227 galons
Lat at noon 4. 6 N

Wednesday 21st

This morning Analan's Island in sight
set up 4 shooks No. 21. 224, 22. 228, 23. 288, 35. 283,
