Fine breeze with thick haze weather steering
Lat at noon 26. 52 N

Tuesday 23rd
This morning took in sail to a close reef main top-
sail, broad heavy all day

Wednesday 24th
This day strong gales and thick haze weather
with rain at intervals heading E. variable No obs.

Thursday 25th
This morning made sail moderate breeze
more ship headed N.W. foggy all the day No obs.

Friday 26th
First part of this day rain and fog heading N.E. by N
Later part clear Lat at noon 26. 19 N

Saturday 27th Long Lunar at 4 o'clock 147. 8 E.
This day moderate and haze weather heading N.E.

Sunday 28th Lat at noon 27. 41 N
Light breeze and a calm this day Lat at noon 28. 22 N

Monday 29th
This day spoke the ship Oregon saw her & saw Whales
Lat at noon 28. 20 N

Tuesday 30th
Fine moderate weather the Oregon in sight made
a barrel of the whale in 60 Lat at noon 28. 44 N

Wednesday 1st May
Light breeze and clear weather remade on 11 pm
Lat at noon 29. 06 N

Strong breeze from the N.E. and cloudy

Moderate breeze and fine weather heading
E. N.E. most part of this day Lat at noon 30. 15 N

Wednesday 8th
Strong breeze and cloudy the most part of this
day spoke the ship Three Brothers of Portland
34 months built 1800 tons Lat at noon 30. 25 N

Thursday 9th
Light breeze and variable cloudy the most
part of the day Long Lunar at 10 o'clock 157. 8 E.

Friday 10th
Fine weather this day at 2 o'clock lowered for
Whales the Larboard boat took one Lat at noon 29. 45

Saturday 11th
This morning cut in the whale sight the ship
Three Brothers cloudy weather throughout the day

Sunday 12th
This day boiling saw two sail at 3 o'clock lowered
for Whales no success

Monday 13th
This morning finished boiling at day light saw Whales
lowered the Larboard boat took one and cut him on
in the afternoon

Tuesday 14th
This day boiling saw a ship to leeward of us
Lat at noon 29. 48

Wednesday 15th
Strong gales and cloudy weather took in sail
to a close reef main topmast and fore sail

Thursday 16th
Moderate breeze and rain the most part of this
day

Moderate and cloudy weather this day Coopers
six small cask of oil and some rice to the
