Sunday 14th

Fine Moderate weather two sail in sight Lat 29. 19 N.

Monday 15th

Fine Moderate weather trim'd four bbls. 1 for tar & 3 for oil
Two sail in sight Lat at noon 29. 14 N.

Tuesday 16th

Fine Weather this day two sail in sight Remade one old
60 that contain'd corn. Rig'd out the flying jib boom
sent up the fore top gallant mast Lat 29. 26 N.

Wednesday 17th

Fine weather this day saw two sail Remade one
old bbl. and trim'd two for oil Lat 29. 38 N.

Thursday 18th

Fine weather and a strong breeze remade one old
Rice and trim'd a 60 that contain'd 11 Apples. Lat. 29. 22 N.

Friday 19th

Fine weather and Moderate breezes saw a Barque to leeward
of us, made two 11th Rice Lat at noon 30. 09 N.

Long & Lunar at 11 O'clock 166. 36 E.

Saturday 20th

Fine Weather this day saw a ship to leeward of us. made
two 10th Rice and trim'd one bbl. Lat at noon 30. 26 N.

Sunday 21st

Fine weather this day saw three sail one to leeward chasing
whales pass'd our bow at sun set Lat at noon 29. 49 N.

Monday 22nd

Long & Lunar at 2 O'clock 169. 3. East
This morning took out the fore lode for Borda and Horta four cash
badly damaged saw two sail Lat at noon 29. 39 N.

Tuesday 23rd

Long & Lunar at 5 O'clock 169. 48 E.
Fine weather this day spoke the ship Zepher of N. Bedford
14 Months out 400 bbls. Lat at noon 29. 35 N. E.

Wednesday 24th

Long & Lunar at 3 O'clock 169. 53. 30 E.
Fine clear Weather this day four sail in sight made one
10th Rice Lat at noon 29. 42 N.

Thursday 25th

Long & Lunar at 4 O'clock 170. 48 E.
This day calm and very warm made one large Rice
Lat at noon 29. 50

Friday 26th July 1844

Fine Moderate breezes two sail in sight at day
light saw black fish made one 10th Rice trim'd one bbl.
for oil at sun set spoke the Young Hero of Nantucket
27 Months 1100 Oia Mitchel 38 Months 1000 bbls. Lat 29. 56 N.

Saturday 27th

Fine Moderate weather this day saw three sail Lat 29. 58

Sunday 28th

Moderate weather this day spoke the Barque Hama
240 bbls this season Lat 30. 16 N.

Monday 29th

This morning saw a ship and Barque off our weather quarter.
in the afternoon saw a ship off our le bow shoofa two old Rice
made one of them trim'd two bbls. Lat 30. 10 N.

Tuesday 30th

This morning fine sail in sight remade one old Rice Lat 30. 40 N.

Wednesday 31st

Fine weather this day made one 14th Rice Lat 31. 32 N.

Thursday 1st August

Fine weather this day made one 10th Rice Lat 31. 22 N.

Friday 2nd

Strong breezes and passing showers of rain Lat 30. 22

Saturday 3rd

Strong breezes and squally at intervals saw a ship pass to leeward
of us Lat. 29. 52 N.

Sunday 4th

Long at 9 O'clock & Lunar. 174. 38. E.
Weather as yesterday saw the same sail this morning heading
off about N.W. Lat 30. 15 N.

Monday 5th

Strong breezes and clear Weather saw two sail
to leeward of us Lat 30. 43 N.

Tuesday 6th

Long at 10 O'clock & Lunar 175. 51. 30 E.
Strong breezes and passing squalls of rain saw a ship
off our le quarter Lat 29. 33

Wednesday 7th

Long at 10 O'clock & Lunar 175. 58 E.
Strong breezes and squally throughout the day Lat 29. 40
