

## Remarks On board

Monday January 19<sup>th</sup> 1845  
commences with light winds steering East  
at 4 took in life sails and a back head  
ing to the North West 4 boats off hull 5  
schooners took 5 to the ship cut in 2  
boiling at daylight hooked down  
cutting hove in 1 while the other  
part of the chain made sail  
held him along side and cut him  
in blowing a gale all the time  
34.203 No Obs to Day  
166.202

Tuesday January 20<sup>th</sup>  
boiling and cutting at 3 p.m.  
cutting at 8 a heavy squall at  
10 P.M. thunder and lightning  
with a plenty rain at 3 p.m.  
foresail & coald down at 5. At 11  
it moderates a little started the  
watch still a heavy gale from  
S West

Lat 36 34  
Dr Long 166 00

Wednesday January 21<sup>st</sup>  
commences with a gale the watch  
employed cutting junk and boiling at 6  
were ship to S East at 11 P.M. furled  
foresail and coald down again  
wind S by East a craft sea running  
at daylight it blows heavy Wind  
W S West at 9 reefed foresail set  
it tumbled in starboard boat  
a heavy sea running

## Ship Noctozuma

Thursday January 22<sup>nd</sup> 1845  
commences with a gale from W S West  
at 2 past 3 P.M. were ship to the South  
at daylight life air at S S West made  
sail coald down at 4 A.M.  
washed off deck tumbled up  
started the watch again at  
sunrise

Friday January 23<sup>rd</sup>  
commences with Moderate  
weather but a heavy sea running  
at 7 coald down for good and  
all tumbled up 105 lbs after  
it blowing a gale 1 week or 5 days  
lost about 15 lbs run out and washed  
overboard by the sea at daylight  
made sail to the W S West  
life air at noon nearly calm

Lat 36 10

Saturday January 24<sup>th</sup>  
commences with a calm broke out  
fore hole to extract sperm oil at 7  
took in sail were ship to S East  
at daylight stowing down oil starting  
watch ran porpoises a breeze  
sprung up at 11 West made all  
sail to the S West
