Sunday January 25th 1846

commences with a strong breeze at 3 PM
stood off the hole stood 105 lbs and
washed of the ship at 4 took in sail
heading S West
at daylight made sail like wind
at 6 AM East steering W S West

Long 166 " 37

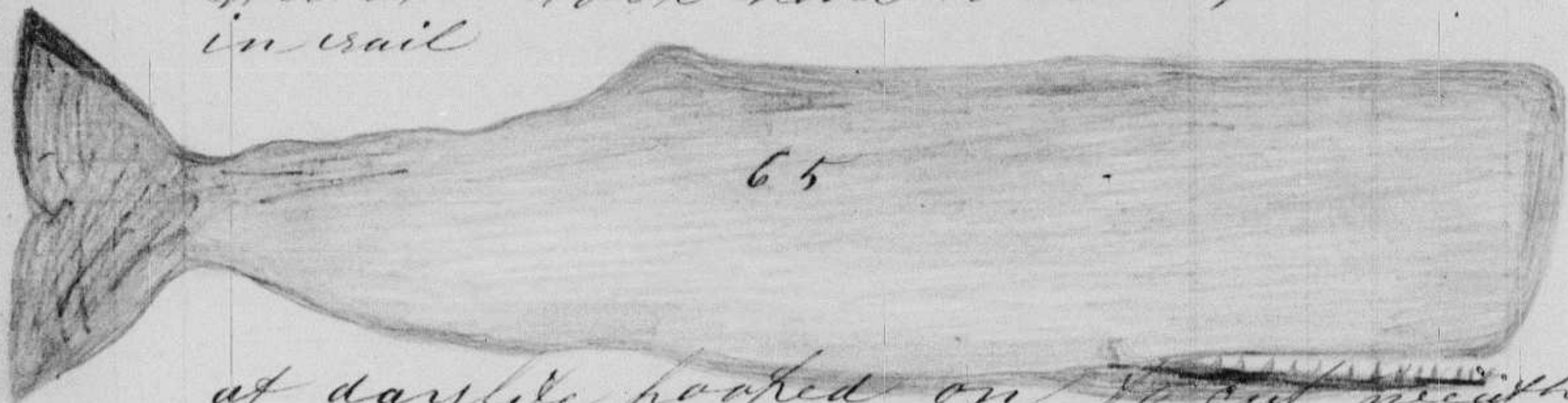
Monday January 26th

commences with like breezes from the
Eastward saw grampages cours S West
at 4 halled to the wind S E took in
like sails closed down topsails halled
up fore cours & c
at daylight made steering S West
at 4 halled ship to S East fine
weather

Tuesday January 27th

commences with like winds at
N E East at 2 past 1 saw sperm
loosed 4 boats starboard boat
struck took him to the ship took
in sail



at daylight hooked on to cut weather
fine sail in site

Ship Noctezuma

Wednesday January 28th 1846

commences with strong breezes all hands
employed bailing the case at 3 began
to boil at 6 PM spoke ship
Awafranks of palmeth Eldrige
1700 lbs
at daylight made sail wore ship
to the N West the Washouts in site

Long 168 " 15 E

Thursday January 29th

commences with like winds at
S East saw hills at 4 took in
sail wore ship to the Eastward
still bailing at 2 PM cold down
at daylight very like air from S E
cours S East at 10 calm at 12
calm

Friday January 30th

commences calm saw porpoises
puffing pigg sharks & c closed down
topsails fished like sails
at daylight cours East broke out
after hole stood down sperm
oil saw porpoises
