

Remarks on board

Saturday April 18th 1846
commences with a gale from S West
course S E going 7 knots at 4 wheel ropes
parted gave a new set at 4 fell wind off
Lat Obs 41 " 22
Long Obs 173 " 47
D R 174 " 01

Sunday April 19th
commences with April 19th
a gale from N S West at 4 wheel ropes
fore topgallentail staid it away a heavy sea
ruining covers N S West mistle part around
at 4 wheel moderates Lat Obs 43 " 7
Long Obs 171 " 37
D R 171 " 47

Monday April 20th
commences with a hail storm took
in the topsail gill reefed the chain courses
N S E wind West at daylight moderates
made sail at 4 blows on again reefed N S
at 11 it lided set Main sail
Lat Obs 44 " 38
Long Obs 169 " 10
D R 168 " 54

Tuesday April 21st
commences with moderate breezes from
N West ward covers N E East opened 2 lbs
sprinkling best at day it ead it e gale
wind S S West at 10 blows on heavy
Lat Obs 46 " 22
D R 167 " 38

Wednesday April 22nd
it commences with a gale from S by W
at 3 1/2 fell took in Mizzen topsail at 5
fall in fore topsail 1/2 fore sail at 8
close reefed Main topsail set staysails
have the ship too heading West at 12 it all
blows a hurricane blow away
topmast staysail and parted
outer bob stays sounds stormy
Lat Obs 47 " 21
D R Long 167 " 15

Ship Nocteyuma

Thursday April 23rd 1846
commences with a hurricane from
S S West at 4 it all parted off topsail
brace put a preventer brace ships grate
a quantity of water at midnight parted
the topsail sheet blow away the sail
Lat Obs 47 " 26
Long D R 168 " 30

Friday April 24th
moderates a little still blows heavy
at daylight wind halled to S E at 8 goose
winged fore sail set it and wore ship to East
ward at 9 wind halled to S West and blows
on heavy bent anchor topmast stay sail set
it took in bow boat Lat Obs 47 " 35
Long D R 166 " 20

Saturday April 25th
blows a gale from N S West all the boats
torn up reef off sail furled but 2 stays
at 4 it all set mizzen topsail close
reefed and goose winged fore sail
boarded a sea stove spar board boat
Lat Obs 47 " 7
Long Obs 164 " 18
D R 165 " 00

Sunday April 26th
moderates wind veers 2 points to the
ward at 5 it all very moderate made
sail covers N S E the broke out a new N
topsail put it went down the broken
one rainy blows on again
Lat D R 47 " 35
Long same 163 " 40

Monday April 27th
commences with a gale at 5 it all bent the
new topsail close reefed it took in all
sail have the ship too at daylight
still blows a gale from N S West
to N S West by ring too heading
N S by West
Lat Obs 48 " 47
Long D R 163 " 22
