Tuesday April 28th 1846
commenced with a gale from the West
lying too heading weather at daylight very
imperate made sail at sunset fly gite
Mizen top galent sails moving wind halled
to, sails set up bobsday have topsail
brace blows on with rain

Wednesday April 29th
commenced with a gale from the South with
rain took in all sail but close reefed
M topsail set storm sails have the ship
too heading W by W at 6 PM at daylight
foggy at 5 set fore sail double reefed
M topsail cours W by West rainy
at 10 clears up blows on heavy

Thursday April 30th
commenced with a gale from W by West
cours N by West at 6 have too took in
gore radd close reefed M topsail
at 5 made sail at 9 blows on to agale
at noon took in fore sails gib 3, 2, 1
water

Friday May 1st 1846
commenced with a gale from W by West
heading N by East at 2 took in fore sail at
3 close reefed M topsail at 4 moderates
a little at daylight a strong storm with
a gale

Saturday May 2nd
a gale and in a storm wind W by W
at 4 set fore sail moderates at daylight
wind S East blowing on squeezed
the yards run W by West till 10 have too
took in fore sail again blows heavy

Sunday May 3rd 1846
commenced with strong winds from S by W
with a heavy sea at 2 set fore and Mizen
topsails cours W by West at 4 H took in
topsails fore sail & have too heading S E
W by West at noon gurnet up boats
W more ship to S by W West set goose
winged fore sail

Dr Long 162 " 47

Monday May 4th
close reefed M topsail set storm sails
blows heavy water thick green at daylight
boarded a sea stove board boat at 12 a sea
boarded carried away bobsday Lat part
fine weather made sail saw fin back
grampers

Long Obs 162 " 44

Tuesday May 5th
fine pleasant weather wind South
steering N by West set up bobsday at 4 boat
fore sails at 5 saw a white whale
boarded past came on board took in
sail at daylight moderate weather made
sail and took it in a gale blows a gale

Wednesday May 6th
commenced with fine May 6th
heavy gale from S by West heading N by South
cours W by West lying too at 4 four heads

moderates wind S by West water green
at life wind at 12 calm at noon
life airs from S East at 1 part 8
saw a white whale going quick
to W by West boarded chest him
a heavy sea heaving N East 3 knots
