Friday May 8<sup>th</sup> 1846  
 calm all these 24 hours at daylight  
 like airs from W. & S. saw  
 porpoises grampuses pillars &c  
 Lat Obs 53 " 06  
 Long D R 163 " 41

Saturday May 9<sup>th</sup>  
 calm commences calm at 3 like air - not  
 at daylight calm a plenty snow  
 Lat past calm Lat Obs 53 " 11  
 Long D R 163 " 57.30

Sunday May 10<sup>th</sup>  
 very like airs from W. & S. saw porpoises  
 finbacks grampuses &c at daylight saw  
 S. West saw humpbacks grampuses  
 finbacks &c at 10 courses W. S. West  
 Lat Obs 52 " 27  
 Long D R 165 " 36

Monday May 11<sup>th</sup>  
 strong breezes from W. & S. write  
 whales loared chart going quick  
 at 4 took in sail at daylight  
 saw white whales loared quick  
 one killed & took him to the ship  
 and cut her in  
 Lat Obs 52 " 00  
 D R Long 166 " 10

Tuesday May 12<sup>th</sup>  
 cutting, blows a gale at 10 W. West  
 at 4 like airs took in sail  
 at daylight clearing away the head  
 hauled up the small hove in  
 the blubber one chain parted  
 1 one sail in site  
 the first for  
 4 months Lat Obs 51 " 54  
 D R Long 166 " 00

Wednesday May 13<sup>th</sup> 1846  
 Whales commences with a gale from the  
 W. & West 1 ship in sight at 1 P. M. more  
 ship to S. W. by S took in sail  
 at daylight blows strong at 5 more ship  
 to the N. West

Thursday May 14<sup>th</sup>  
 strong breezes from S. West steering  
 to W. & S. a sail in site Capt  
 sick powder sick at daylight saw  
 Whales finbacks 1 sail in site  
 Lat Obs 52 " 03  
 Long D R 166 " 25

Friday May 15<sup>th</sup>  
 blows strong from S. West still boiling  
 at 2 more ship at 10 more ship wind  
 West saw humpbacks finbacks 1 white  
 whale at 4 P. M. loared the boat did  
 not fasten at daylight like wind a plenty  
 finbacks at 10 oil  
 Lat Obs 51 " 58  
 Long D R 166 " 15

Saturday May 16<sup>th</sup>  
 commences with like weather at  
 S. West 1 ship to south at  
 4 P. M. 1 sail in site saw finbacks  
 finished steaming at 8 P. M.  
 at 8 P. M. loared chart a whale  
 very wild could not write  
 Lat Obs 52 " 01  
 Long D R 166 " 25

Sunday May 17<sup>th</sup>  
 strong breezes at W. West saw 1  
 whale spoke ship a plank in  
 mistic no ends with hail at day  
 like strong breezes at 8 took in  
 topsails blade fell away hove too  
 a heavy sea on  
 Lat Obs 51 " 50  
 Long D R 166 " 10
