Friday May 29th 1848
commenced with a calm, boiling out
Whales at daylight a whale in sight laded chart
him shy, broke out fore peak
Lat 46 57 " 30
Long D R 165 " 55

Saturday May 30th
fine weather, laded chart whale with
success took in sail wore ship to S by E
Whales still boiling at daylight blows on the
a gale at 10 close reefed M. fore sail reefed
fore sail could down stowing down
oil at noon put on hatches
Lat D R 54 " 00
166 " 10

Sunday May 31st
a gale with rain from E by S lashed
up the oil fanned up, started a
boat at daylight like air with a high sea
running at 11 commenced, working again

Monday June 1st 1846
commences with like air from the North
at 4 fog at daylight like air from S by E
covers N E by N the stowing oil in
finbacks
Lat D R 51 " 25
Long 165 " 40

Tuesday June 2nd
commences with like winds at 11 AM
Whales ran up, laded chart without
hook took in sail at daylight made
sail spearing 48 West spearing off fore
hole at 9 chart 2 whales going quick to
windward a plenty finbacks in
sight
Lat 46 51 " 40
165 " 45
Long 161 " 10

2 whales stood down 2 40 lbs
checked off Laar hole

Wednesday June 3rd 1846
strong breezes from S East at 8 wind
last were ship took in sail sped off
Whales Laar hole Laar hole is full captain
is sick at daylight finbacks in sight at 8 were
ship to S East at 11 wore to S East
chart a whale with success
sped off

Long D R 165 " 30

Thursday June 4th
wind like rain finbacks hump backs 9c at 4 PM
saw 3 gains of rib whales took in sail
at daylight hump backs in sight at 8 sight whales
laded and prepared at 11 laded again gale
him

Long D R 165 " 30

Friday June 5th
at 2 PM started sail wore ship at 8
a plenty finbacks in sight at 5 PM blows
a gale from S West
Lat 46 51 " 15
D R Long 165 " 25

Saturday June 6th
commences with a gale from S West at 8 wore
ship close reefed M. fore sail reefed fore sail took in
boat fanned up quarter 22. Waist boat
at daylight blows strong very rugged sea high
backs grand passes 9c
Lat 46 51 " 42
Long 165 " 15
165 " 11

Sunday June 7th
moderates at 1 wore ship to S West
saw finbacks at daylight calm hump
backs in sight at 8 like wind from
the North covers S West spoke bargue
W. and stowing on 60 lbs blows
on to a gale the wind S East
