

Remarks on board

Monday June 8th 1846
commences with a gale from the N.E. &
to N.W. West covers S West at 4:30 took
in fore & mizzen topsails & set humpbacks
at 4 close reefed mizzen sail furl fore sail
at daylight a strong gale with snow at noon

Long Wm 164 " 04
D. P. 166 " 36

Tuesday June 9th
comm with moderate weather wore ship & set
mizzen sail covers & set 1 barque in site
saw humpbacks at daylight saw 1 barque & 1
humpback

Long Wm 164 " 36
D. P. 164 " 19
S. P. Long 165 " 17

Wednesday June 10th
blows a gale at 3 saw 1 whale at 4
hoisted but could do nothing it being riced
back in sail 1 sail in site
at daylight blows a gale very riced
saw a plenty humpbacks & sulphur bottom
2 sails in site

Long Wm 165 " 32

Thursday June 11th
moderate at 4 spoke ship (bed) & checked
gained with her got some small things
let him have a spyglass at 4 took in
sail at daylight like air at noon
remains calm all day Lat 50 00

Friday June 12th
Whales calm furl mizzen in site picked up a spot
2 H. Long at daylight calm at 9 saw 3
whales & hoisted chart 1 sail in site

Lat 52 " 26
Long Wm 165 " 18

Saturday June 13th
Whale like wind hoisted chart whales spoke
B. Warren at daylight a gale so ends

No Obs 52 40
165 30 W

Sunday June 7th 1846
a gale lying too in storm sails
by D. P. Lat 52 " 15
Long 165 " 50

Monday June 15th
Moderates at daylight saw whales
wore ship at 10 wore ship

Lat 52 " 02
D. P. Long 165 " 58

Tuesday 16th
Toared chart whales
very shy at dark took in sail for the
night at 5 a.m. hoisted for Whales
very wild at 10 hoisted and chased
as usual the watch employed in
scrapping Bone so ends this day

Lat 51 " 59
Long 165 " 50

Wednesday 17th
Commences with calm weather
steering N.E. at 1 P.M. a light
air from S.W. saw Hump Back
Chased Whales for the last 20 days
with out striking hard work
and no prospect
at day light saw Humpbacks
Course N by E so ends this
no Obs. 52 10

Thursday 18th
Calm with fine weather and
no Whales at dark saw 1 Wright
Whale going quick to the westward
Course E at daylight strong
wind and fog from S.E. steering by
N.E. by E at 11:00 Lat 53 " 18
Long 163 " 12

Friday June 19th
foggy at 5:00
ship reefed topsails furl mizzen sail at daylight
fine weather wind South by West course by S
at 10:00 peers to S East steering by
E by East saw humpbacks
Lat 53 " 16
Long Wm 161 " 56
