

Remarks On board Ship

Saturday Sept 17th 1846
strong breeze took in a raft water
80

Sunday Sept 20th 1846
strong breeze ship went to sea

Monday Sept 21st
fine weather there 24 hours 1 ship arrived

Tuesday Sept 22nd
like showers of rain 1 ship came in 3 whels

Wednesday Sept 23rd fine weather
taking in provisions

Thursday Sept 24th
like wind with out rain 3 ships arrived
one went to sea

Friday Sept 25th
taking in potatoes at 7 grainy riding
up weighing

Saturday Sept 26th
tarring weighing taking in sweet potatoes
water fruit vegetables &c

Sunday Sept 27th
all ready for sea at daylight have
shot at 10 AM took over anchor
and went to sea leaving 12 ships
in port

Monday Sept 28th 158° W 203° N
stood the anchors cleared the deck covers
by 8 AM East port off a wh varnish
ed waist ship at 11 PM made all
sail at daylight strong winds
at 10 like air 1 sail inside Lat

Lat 19 " 31
Long 157 " 29

Kortezuma lying in Nochee

Tuesday Sept 27th 1845
commenced with like air from S West
at 4 wind at 18 West 1 ship in site
saw blackfish at daylight calm 1 ship
in site sand spouts repairing rigging top
sail at 9 a breeze from Eastward

Lat 19 " 13
DR Long 157 " 00

Wednesday Sept 30th
strong breezes commenced these 24 hours
covered by S East the watch employed
repairing sails at daylight strong breeze
covered by S East repairing sails 1 sail in
site

Lat 16 " 16
Long 156 " 25

Thursday Sept October 1st 1846
commenced with strong breezes ship
Met and uncomfortable at 1/2 past 8
spoke ship galconada of Bedford
steadily 1500 lbs covered by S by South
at daylight strong breezes at 1/2 by South
covered S by South sent in fly gib
to repair

Lat 14 " 35
Long 153 " 49

Friday Oct 2nd
strong breezes at 1/2 East
at 4 AM spoke ship galconada
gained at daylight strong breeze the wind
veers to the Eastward

Lat 12 " 35 N
Long 155 " 13

Sat Oct 3rd
strong breezes 1 ship in site, repairing
sails at 10 strong breezes at 4 parted
Martingill gear, sail still in use
the watch employed in setting
up weighing

Lat DR 10 " 29
Long DR 154 " 20
