commenced with light winds squally
with rain wind at East covers by ESE
at dark the wind veers to the North

squally wind veers to SE East at 7
halts to NE East 1 sail in sight
at daylight light airs repairing sails

commenced with light winds at 5 sandhury
backs wet hals at 4 calm
at daylight light airs sand a breeze
Lat 1 " 23 miles South

Monday Oct 11th
strong breezes these 24 hours covers
by SE West South at 12 still wind
veers to the North covers by SE 6, SE 3
at daylight rent down fore sail
to repair
