Thursday November 5th 1846
commences with light winds variable
from S to W by West at 4 strong
breeze from the Westward
at 8 hook in like sails at 11 furled
Main cours double reefed fore & 2nd M topsail
of furled gill at 1 blows a gale hook in
topsails courses & 2nd placed away topmast
stay sail at 5 P.M. close reefed all topsail
at 9 bent a topmast stay sail ships a great
quantity water casks bad

Long same 165 " 50

Friday November 6th
Moderates a little at 8 blows a
smart gale with a bad sea raining
at daylighte a gale Lat post the same
made sail Lat by Obs 30 " 56
more ship

Long Obs 166 " 50

Saturday November 7th
hook in topsails blows a gale at 2 mod-
erates set fore topsail at 4 wore ship
to Westward set Mizzen topsail & 2nd gill
at daylighte made sail to S East

November 7th
Strong breezes at S by West
wore ship to Westward lat post
like airs

Sunday November 8th
commences with light winds from the
S by West at noon 5 mins veers
to the Eastward
