Saturday November 28<sup>th</sup> 1840  
commenced with more moderate  
weather at 2 began to bail on ship  
inside at daylight still blows a gale  
ware ship to the N West

Lat by Obs 42 " 05

Sunday November 29<sup>th</sup>  
Long 158 " 12

commenced with moderate gale wind  
veers to S West heading N by E  
at 3 P.M. could down  
at daylight wind hails to S West a lite  
breaze set all sail at 10 ware ship  
to South wind veers to N West

Lat by Obs 41 " 52

Monday November 30<sup>th</sup>  
a lite breaze from the N West  
cours by S West one sail inside  
took in sail at 7 at daylight made  
sail one ship in site at 10 ware  
ship to the South

Long 158 " 06

Tuesday December 1<sup>st</sup> 1840  
commenced with a strong breaze  
from off the South coast by South  
at 3 took in mainsail & gibe  
at daylight strong breezes  
set gibe fogg No Obs

Wednesday December 2<sup>d</sup>  
more moderate at 3 set gibe cours  
by South at 4 weather fine  
at daylight made sail at 7 took in  
sail broke out to shore at  
at 11 saw a whale breazed  
struck him but the line with the  
lance

# Ship Montezuma

Whale Thursday December 3<sup>d</sup> 1840  
blows a gale wind S West storming  
oil at 8 finished at 4 took in sail  
at daylight still a gale heading South

Friday November 4<sup>th</sup>  
still blows strong a heavy sea  
running wind N West heading  
South

Lat by Obs 44 " 57

Saturday December 5<sup>th</sup>  
Moderates a little, foggy wind  
N by South at daylight lite wind  
with a thick fog at 9 moderate  
ware ship to N West

Lat by Obs 45 " 07

Sunday December 6<sup>th</sup>  
commenced with lite winds at 5  
at 5 took ship to S West  
at daylight wind more moderate at  
9 gam whales loared partned too  
him and drawn No Obs to Day

Monday December 7<sup>th</sup>  
wind lite fith fogg at 7 took  
in sail and ware ship to N West  
at daylight made sail one ship in site  
saw a whale loared with out  
success at 10 loared a gam  
with out success spoke ship  
backs Mystic fogg saw fin
