Tuesday December 8th 1848
commenced with like weather and
fog took in like sails at daylight
strong breezes made all sail to W by South
thick fog and rain at noon clears off

Long by Obs 157 .. 02

Wednesday December 9th

commenced with strong breezes took
in all sail and like sails at 4 took
in sail heading S by West

at 7 AM wind at N by West accompanied
with rain and fog at 11 wind hauled
to W by West close reefed all topsail

Lat by Obs 46 21

Thursday December 10th

strong breezes at noon wind shifted
to W by West at 5 set fore sail
wore ship to course N by East
at 8 PM blows a gale from S by West
at noon wind W by West moderates
set fore sail

Lat by Obs 46 22

Friday December 11th

a gale at N by West took in fore
sail one ship in sight the weather
thick & raining at daylight wind
S by West and 1 blows a Hurricane
at noon moderates

carried away
inner cabin
for the 4th
time

Lat by Obs 45 .. 54

Ship Kootzenma

Saturday December 12th 1848
commenced with strong breezes wind
W by West at daylight 1st all hands
wired in by West thick and raining
at 10 AM blows a gale

Sunday December 13th

raining moderates at 5 clears off at 8
wand a ship heading S by West under
short sail at daylight wind W by West
with a gale of wind at 8 made sail
course East and a sail steering
East by S made sail kept off course
took in how best Lat by Obs 45 .. 11

Long by Obs 152 .. 55

Monday December 14th

commenced with a gale from S by West
course East one ship in sight
at daylight blows heavy in squalls
hauled up waist boat took in top gal
ent all sails up set fore sail repaired
and set it at 11 made all sail

Lat by Obs 45 .. 21

Long by Obs 149 .. 00

Tuesday December 15th

a gale at West course East at daylight
at 4 PM course East at daylight
still gale all hands West
course East Lat 45 30
