

Remarks On board

January 18th 1847
commences with a gale from the S West
went ashore after muskets ducks &c
at 2 let go 2nd anchor
at daylight or 7th it blows a gale at North West
and veers to S West and Moderates

January 19th
weather fine ashore catching in rabbits
ducks &c at 4 it blows a gale lat 3 54 N
at 4 moderates have short took the anchor
made sail stood out the North passage
at 10 p. got an altitude for the chronom.
Long at 10 46 off is north head

at noon Lat by Obs 51 " 41

Monday January 18th
commences with strong breezes at
off S West at 5 PM passed the Jarans
islands bearing E by North 15 miles best
flat island bearing N E by East 20 miles
coast N E East the ship Laver in size
left ships Atlantic Nan-tas-tet 8th fine
habitation harbour at 7th fine
weather wind W S W at 10 blows a gale

Lat by Obs 50 " 00
Long by Chron 59 " 50

Tuesday January 19th
commences with fine weather
wind S West coast is East
one ship in sight all hands
putting back at 7th
wind veers to the North
saw plenty fin backs

Lat by Obs 48 " 52
Long by Chron 57 " 24

Ship Noctezuma

Wednesday January 20th 1847
commences with strong breezes from the S West
steering by E by North at 4 back in life
sails double reefed topsails & ship in sight
at 4 it blows a like gale from the
N West at 11 foggy made sail canvas by N West

Lat 48 " 11
Long 55 " 25

Thursday January 21st

thick fog with strong breezes at 5
took in sail at 5 made sail strong
breezes at 8 foggy at noon wind let
at W S W saw fin backs

Lat by Obs 47 " 10

Long D R 54 " 25

Friday January 22nd

commences with like air with fog
at 3 wind at West at 5 at 3 West
clears off strong breezes saw a ship
took in sail at 4 have too
at 8 made sail steering North spoke
ship Sibirien S Harbour 4th 800 spars
saw fin backs

Lat by Obs 48 " 40

Long Chron 53 " 45

Saturday January 23rd
strong breezes at W S W wore
ship took in sail at 3 wore ship
set gill course at West at 4 made
sail covers S West at 7 sent down
Mizzen topsail repaired it at noon
sent it spoke the Sibirien

Lat by Obs 46 " 30

Long D R 54 " 00

Left the Jarans islands
the 17th after dark at anchorage
the 18th Jarans at 8 PM
