Wednesday February 10<sup>th</sup> 1847  
commences with bad weather at 5  
could down at 4 rainy wind at 8 PM  
were ship to NE took in sail  
at daylight a gale from NW  
a plenty whales in sight  
Lat by Obs 44 " 29

Thursday February 11<sup>th</sup>  
commences with a gale at 5 were  
ship to NE East chase regular than  
topsail reefed fore sail and were  
whales at 4 still blows a gale at 4 PM  
were ship and a whale at noon at  
moderates a little

Friday February 12<sup>th</sup>  
at 8 were ship made sail to  
SSE West at 7 calm at dark  
wind hauled to South at 9 were ship to  
Westward at 5 made sail at 9 were  
out reef set main sail were ship to  
SSE

Saturday February 13<sup>th</sup>  
commences with squally  
breezes from the SE West at 5 hauled  
West covers by SSE West at daylight  
at 11 blows a gale took in all sail  
hove to at 4 made sail to Westward  
finbacks in sight and 2 sails one  
cutting

Sunday February 14<sup>th</sup>  
Whales 2 sails in sight wind like at 11 SSE  
at 10 took ship at 1 fair wind at daylight  
hoisted chart at 9 chart at 1 chart  
could not strike 5 sails in sight  
Lat by Obs 44 " 26

# Ship Kootzenia

Monday February 15<sup>th</sup> 1847  
commences with late winds from  
the East chasing Whales 7 ships in  
sight took in sail  
at daylight wind set back out to stand  
ail in main hatch way  
Lat by Obs 45 " 00  
Long by Obs 49 " 04

Tuesday February 16<sup>th</sup>  
commences with strong breeze from the  
North east whales 5 ships in sight one  
ship cutting at daylight wind set  
Whales made sail at 5 were ship to SSE  
young spoke ships New York Henry & Thomas  
quick greenport Atlantic Mystic each 2 whales

Wednesday February 17<sup>th</sup>  
blows squally at daylight at 8 took  
in sail were ship to the NE by East 2  
ships in sight at daylight blows a gale  
at 11 West accompanied with rain at 10 made  
sail

Thursday February 18<sup>th</sup>  
commences with a heavy squall took  
in sail at 4 made sail a gun covers  
at 7 AM blows on took in sail  
hove ship to at 5 fore noon  
set fore sail gib fore topsail cover  
at 11 shiped a sea in board  
boat broke her down took her in  
took in fore topsail & gib  
blows heavy in squalls wind  
SSE
