Friday February 19th 1847

commenced with a S West gale at 1 PM took in fore sail from ship too at 7 moderate at 12 fine weather at daylight made sail covers by N East strong breeze saw a small whale going quick toward east after him

Saturday February 20th commenced with strong breezes from N West at 6 a thunder squalls with rain covers at the at daylight strong breezes later part moderate

Sunday February 21st commenced with like winds at N West covers by N West set all sail at daylight strong breezes from the North near to the eastward caught a porpoise

Monday February 22nd commenced with strong breezes from the N East covers by N East took in flygill at daylight wind like at 10 covers by East

Wednesday February 24th 1847 commenced with strong breezes from S West covers by S West under all sails at daylight like squally weather wind N West the watch employed cleaning tops and putting royal yards

Thursday February 25th commenced with like winds at West covers by West at daylight wind N West bent and sent up royal fore 3rd Main topmast and top galent sails covered by E wind like

Friday February 26th like winds from N West covers by E under all sail at daylight wind from S East for near to N East saw blackfish

Saturday February 27th commenced with like breezes from the N East halled in standing sails covers by N West the watch employed in putting White at daylight strong breezes from the E S E

Sunday February 28th strong breezes at 5 took in flygill 3rd Main covers by E at daylight the wing of N East at 9 took in ship to E by South strong breezes later part struck a porpoise lost him
