

Wednesday the 8th September
 This hours commenced with light winds
 hands employ'd in the ship's duty At 9 pm
 wind blew from the S.W. the bows S.W.
 look in S.W. sails All the middle part
 strong so ends this 24 hours

Thursday
 the 9th day
 September
 This Day commenced with strong winds
 from the S.W. and buff sea All hands
 employ'd in filling kegs and boats and
 setting yards At 11 in the afternoon
 saw a brig ahead At 5 the mast it beam
 the wind continues strong courses by S.W.
 ends this Day Latitude 41° 22' - Long 59° 18'

Friday
 the 10th day
 This Day commenced with light winds from
 the South clear boat too with starboard
 aboard all hands employ'd in ship's duty
 nothing seen from the West this Day
 but being at 7 pm became calm so ends
 this 24 hours Latitude by observation 41° 28'

Saturday
 the 11th day
 This Day begins with strong winds from
 the S.W. and we lead 8 with starboard
 Sails on board at 9 am took out our potatoes
 and pick'd them over At 11 am became thick
 and rainy sun thunders all hands in
 floor in ship's duty so ends this Day Lat
 titude

Sunday
 the 12th day
 In the morning of the 12 strong winds from
 S.W. and buff sea All hands employ'd in
 ship's duty at 2 in the afternoon saw
 a ship ahead got the lines in the boats
 and got ready for too soon but saw
 them no more At 5 pm wind continued
 strong and became squally so ends this
 Day Latitude 41° 28'

Notured ✓ September the 13th 20
 This Day commenced with gentle gales from
 S.W. and smooth sea at 10 am saw a
 shoal off Whales Roar and struck line
 being king had to cut 2 thirds off it
 At 2 with chased to windward but to no
 success came on board and hoisted the
 boats wind continues light saw 2 sails
 just at night so ends this Day Latitude 41°

Tuesday
 the 14th
 Day
 This Day commenced with light winds from
 the S.W. At 7 in the morning saw a long whale
 At 8 found and at 10 got underway to Dart
 but mist him chased till 12 and then came
 on board and hoisted up the boats and got
 dinner saw long shoals off blackfish all
 hands employ'd in ship's duty so ends this
 Days Drift Latitude by observation 40° 36'

Wednesday
 the 15th day
 This Day fine weather at 7 am board for Whales
 struck and saved 2 calves but them in
 sunset cut up the hanks and the
 ben saw 2 sails leaving West fine
 All hands employ'd in setting up
 so ends this Day Latitude

Thursday
 the 16th day
 This Day commenced with light wind
 and smooth sea began to boil at 11 pm
 tonight saw several finbacks this Day
 and blackfish turned up 15th off out so
 ends this Day Latitude

Friday
 the 17th
 Day
 This Day fine day with buff sea and
 sun rain we hatched below and the
 rest employ'd in ship's duty saw a
 brig standing to the West so ends this
 Day Latitude
