Wednesday the 30 th	This Day Commenced with gentle ^{gales} from the S.E. and Clear Weather the Steer East. haul with Low tacks one watch below and the rest Employ'd in Ships Duty at 8 pm The Wind breezed so ends this Day Latitude 32.50	Tuesday the 6 th Day	This Day Commenced with fine wether light Wind from the S.E. and remarkable smooth sea Broke up the fore cone and got up line and then stowed down again brook up the potatoes and picked them over Saw 2 Sails astern so ends this Day with light wind Latitude 25.24 S.
Thursday the 1 st Day October	This Day Commenced with fine breeze from the S.E. Steer S.W. watch below and the rest Employ'd in Ships Duty at 7 pm Cook in the Royals fine breeze and smooth sea so ends this Day Latitude 32.1	Wednesday the 7 th Day	This Day Commenced with light winds from the S.E. and smooth sea all hands Employ'd in squaring the fore and main Riggers in the afternoon lowered the backstays and battled the fore riggin one side so ends this Day with fine weather and nothing seen from the mast head Latitude by observation 24.13 S.
Friday the 2 ^d Day October	This Day Commenced with gentle gales from the S.E. and smooth sea work out for the hoops scopped them all and put them back at 2 pm Saw 2 Sails Astern continues fine all Day so ends this Day Latitude 32.5 S.	Thursday the 8 th Day	This Day Commenced with fine wether Wind about S.E. by E. Course S by N and smooth sea all hands Employ'd in fitting the riggin at 2 pm Saw 2 Sails off the lee bow about 45 miles off All this Day fine wether Saw a school of black fish so ends the Day Latitude 25.11 S.
Saturday the 3 ^d Day	this 24 hours Commenced with light wind from the S.E. Course S by N, watch below and the rest Employ'd in Ships Duty at 7 pm the Wind would move to the East and we squared in the yards so ends this Day Latitude 29.2	Friday the 9 th Day	This Day Commenced with gentle gales from the S.E. and smooth sea Course S by N all hands Employ'd in fitting the riggin Saw 2 Sails the afternoon strong hills and buff sea at 4 pm took in the main tacking sail so ends this Day Latitude 25.5 S.
Sunday the 4 th Day off	this Day Commenced with fine wether and light wind from the S.E. Course S by N brook up the after hatch and got up Corn and bread and meat stowed down again nothing doing the Remainder part of the Day so ends this Day Latitude 27.8 S.	Saturday the 10 th Day	This Day Commenced with strong winds from the S.E. Course S by N and smooth sea 1 watch below and the rest Employ'd in Ships Duty nothing seen from the mast head at night the wind breezed so ends this Day with thick squally wether Latitude 19.4 S.
Monday the 5 th Day	This Day Commenced with fine wether and light wind from the S.E. Course S by N brook up the main hole and got up water at 4 in the after noon finish'd Saw 2 Gallanties Steaming about N by S so ends this Day with light Wind Latitude 26.17 S.	Sunday the 11 th Day	This Day Commenced with strong winds from the S.E. Course S by N and thick hazy wether about 10 am thickened up and until on half past here was the land sight over the sea and we headed right on going at the rate of ten S. haul'd in the Steering Sails and kept off west about 2 pm saw about 3 Sails ahead went in water between thick and thin so ends this Day Latitude 17.4 S.
