the 27th Day

This Day commenced with strong Gale from S.W. and a stiff sea took the topsails and Lay too till 5 pm then Gale abated and lost the foresail and the sail sea fell considerable took in the waste boat and lashed her so ends this Day Latitude 43° 50' South Correc 9.2

Sunday
the 28th Day

This Day commenced with gentle Gale from S.W. and smooth sea looking doing this Day at 7 pm the wind but to be S.W. and the ship was off in the evening had the ship and down about 10 sails and foresail and the mast stowed so ends this Day strong Gale Latitude 43° 57' Correc 9.7

Monday
the 29th Day

This Day commenced with heavy Gale from S.W. and small rain Lay too when lost most main topsail and kept by sails till 5 in the afternoon then the wind hauled too and the ship became more moderate mail more sail so ends this Day Latitude 45° 00' Correc 9.12

Tuesday
the 30th Day

This Day commenced with strong wind from S.W. and a stiff sea took the topsails and the mast Employed to get the fore and main spence and bent her got the topsail off hook and stowed nothing more remarkable record so ends this Day at strong wind and head last sea Latitude by observation 45° 40' Correc 9.47

This Day commenced with strong winds and squalls of rain from S.W. and a stiff sea at 2 pm hauled to the South and lifted on took in the fore and main topsail and lost reef the main and kept the foresail at 5 pm more ship and sail headed to the S.W. till 7 pm and the lost the fore sail and fore topsail so ends this Day Latitude 49° South Correc 9.57

This Day commenced with gentle Gale from S.W. and a stiff sea took the topsails and the mast Employed to get the fore and main spence and bent her got the topsail off hook and stowed nothing more remarkable record so ends this Day at strong wind and head last sea Latitude by observation 49° 40' Correc 9.62
