Friday
the 3rd
February

This Day commenced with fine weather
Employed in getting vegetables on board
Hervell vessels came in this Day besides
A French 18 gun brig at 3 pm Mon moved
off 5 pm got under way and put
to sea at 8 pm got the anchors secured
and got supper set the watch so ends
This Day Latitude 33° 1 South

Saturday
the 4th
February

This Day commenced with gentle breezes from
the South and thick hazy weather hands
Employed in Lashing the anchors and ships
Duty saw the land to the East off us about
10 Leagues Distanced saw from the Deck
8 or 10 great numbers of hump backs &
Nothing more very remarkable found
So ends this Day Latitude 32° 40 South

Saturday
the 5th
February

This Day commenced with gentle winds from
the South and cloudy weather hands
1 Watch below and the rest Employed in ships
Duty Land all long shore about 20 miles off
saw school off black fish Nothing more reman-
table So ends this Day Latitude 31° 20 South

Sunday
the 6th
February

This Day commenced with gentle winds
from the South and smooth sea & other
going on this Day the land about the
same distance off course & by 11 AM
saw several hump backs Nothing more
very remarkable found So ends this Day
Latitude by observation 29° 9 South

Monday
the 7th

This Day commenced with gentle winds from
the South and smooth sea & other
brought down off the Day provisions found that
in pretty good order brook up all the fat
between Decks and hoisted it up Nothing
So ends this Day Latitude 27° 39

Tuesday
the 8th

Running Down the coast of Chile

This Day commenced with gentle breezes from
the South and smooth sea all hands Employed
in fitting the rigging and Taring
It down painted the nails round &
Nothing seen from the mast heads
So ends this Day with fine weather
Latitude 26° 37

Wednesday
the 9th

This Day commenced with fine weather
and smooth sea wind South & course
1 Watch below and the rest Employed in ta-
ring the rigging at 4 pm finished all about
the mast Nothing seen from aloft So ends
this Day with fine weather Latitude 24° 57
Longitude 71° 45 West

Thursday
the 10th
February

This Day commenced with light winds from
the South and smooth sea 1 Watch below
the rest Employed in taring the rigging at
5 pm finished Nothing seen from
the mast head at 6 pm got up the
bustin for stowing down the oil so
Nothing more very remarkable found
So ends this Day Latitude 23° 7

Friday
the 11th
February

This Day commenced with light wind from
the SSW and course & P began and broo
up the fore hole and stowed down the
oil at 5 pm finished and cleared up
the Decks Nothing more very reman-
table found So ends this Day Latitude
by observation 22° 10 South

Saturday
the 12th
February

This Day commenced with light winds
from the South and smooth sea
1 Watch below and the rest Employed in ship
Duty Nothing seen from the mast heads
This Day Latitude 21° 7 South
