Eastward at 9 AM saw the Island of Flores
steering SELE By Compass Dist 60 miles
& fine morning EPE Latitude By OBS 39° 40' N
Longitude By Chs 32° 05' W

Friday
Aug 21st

Commences with a Light Breeze at PM & pleasant
weather steering sharp By PE at 4 PM sent the
small Bow Chain Cable at 4:30 PM showed sail
tong near the Land & tackled to the Westward
Middle & Latter part at 8 AM sent the Boat on shore
the NE side of Flores at noon the Boat returned with
a Load of Potatoes so ended Lying off and on in company
with the Ships - Adams of San Pedro, Fortune of
Plymouth, & Oregon & Stephanie of Bedford.

Saturday
Aug 22nd

During these 24 hours strong Wind & squally with Little rain
Lying off & on near Flores - got another Load of Potatoes

Sunday
Aug 23rd

Commences with strong Wind & squally weather Lying
off and on at 6 PM the Boat returned to the ship
with another Load of vegetables at 8 PM the PE part
of Flores bore N W Dist 3 Leagues from which I take
my departure & took SSE per Compass

Longitude By AC 29° 30' W
Longitude By Chs 29° 13' W

Monday
Aug 24th

During these 24 hours moderate Wind from NW & PM
& fine weather steering SE 4 or 5 knots, the Ship
Fortune in sight to the Eastward
Course SE Dist 120 ms Latitude By OBS 36° 38' N
Longitude By Chs 27° 30' W

Tuesday
Aug 25th

During these 24 hours a Light Wind at PM & clear
pleasant weather steering sharp By NE 5 knots
the crew variously employed doing ships duty
Latitude By OBS 35° 31' N
Longitude By Chs 26° 08' W
