 Nov 11th Commences with a Light Wind from the Westward &

 weather with a high swell from the S.W. steering W.W.
 7 knots. Latter part strong Wind at N.W. & thick
 cloudy weather attended with light rain steering
 W.W. 7 knots with all possible sail set
 Latitude By A.C. $57^{\circ} 42' P$
 Longitude By A.C. $66^{\circ} 09' W$

Thursday
 Nov 12th Commences with a Strong Breeze at N.W. & thick cloudy
 weather steering W.W. 7 knots with foretopmast studding
 sail set at 5 PM heavy squalls from the N.W. took
 in the fore & Mizzen topsails & close reefed Main one
 & reefed the fore & Main Course at 8 PM more
 moderate set close reef fore & mizen topsails
 at 10 midnight equally took fore & mizen topsails
 Latter part strong Wind at N.W. & squally with hail
 & rain made & took in sail accordingly
 Came W.W. Dist 60 miles Latitude By B.P. $58^{\circ} 14' P$
 Long By Choc $67^{\circ} 58' W$
 Long By A.C. $67^{\circ} 54' W$

Friday
 Nov 13th Commences with strong winds at N.W. & squally
 with a rough sea running. Lying By under double
 reef Main & fore sail & close reefed & storm sails
 headed to the S.W. at 4 PM had squalls split
 the Main topsail. Middle part strong Gales at West
 & squally with hail & snow Lying to under Reef & fencer
 & Reef Storm Mizen & foretopmast staysail at 6 PM
 set a Reef & fencer
 Latter part strong Wind at S.W. Lying By under shank
 sail at Noon wore ship to the N.W. to anchor
 Course P.E. Dist 94 ms Latitude By A.C. $58^{\circ} 56' P$
 Longitude By A.C. $67^{\circ} 57' W$

Saturday
 Nov 14th Commences with strong Gales at S.W. attended with
 squalls of hail & snow Lying By headed to the N.W.
 under reef Fencer & storm staysails
 Middle part heavy gales in above took in the fore & fore
 at 6 PM more moderate set reef Main sail & fencer
 Latter part strong Gales at S.W. headed W.W. under
 Reef Courses Latitude By B.P. $59^{\circ} 45' P$
 Course N.P.E. Dist 67 miles Longitude By A.C. $67^{\circ} 26'$

Sunday
 Nov 15th Commences with strong gales at S.W. & thick squally
 weather & rough sea running. Lying By under close reef
 sails at 4 PM bent the Main topsail
 at 7 PM moderate Wind cast the reefs out the topsails
 & Courses & set M.G. & Pail
 Middle part Light Wind at P.B.E. & pleasant steering
 By the Wind S.W. 4 knots
 Latter part Light Wind at W.W. steering sharp By N.W.
 4 knots in sight of the Westward
 Course W.W. Dist 65 ms Latitude By A.C. $57^{\circ} 20' P$
 Longitude By A.C. $69^{\circ} 13'$
