ther steers free to the Westward & Northward
employed fitting Rigging & painting the Boats &c
Lat By O.P. 14° 24'
20 Leagues from Land.

Tuesday
Dec 21st Commences with a moderate Breeze & pleasant steers
NBE at night shortened sail & fine trade to the
Westward Middle & Latter Do
Lat By O.P. 12° 40'

head in the after part of the Mast hatchway &c

Dec 20th Commences with a Light Wind at P^o E steering NE
at 4 P.M. saw the Land Dist 30 miles at 6 P.M.
spoke a schooner from Punta Praya de Lima - at
7 P.M. tacked to the P^o W - saw Porpoises & struck
a small Fish & drew the Craft

Longitude By A.C. 79° 40'
