an American ship of War.
Middle & Latter part Wind Dr - steering NWBN
saw a Fin back Latitude By CBP 8° 48.
Long By GC 79° 30.

Tuesday
Dec 22nd

During these 24 hours Light hades & pleasant
steering to the NW - saw fin backs, employed
refining the Main sail &c. Lat By CBP 7° 40
Long By Chw 81° 00

Wednesday
Dec 23rd

Commences with light hades & pleasant steering
NNW at 2 PM went to the Main sail &
sent another Middle Dr at 5 AM kept the
ship NNE Latter part Calm hazy weather.
at 10 AM caught a swordfish. Lat By GC 6° 40
Long By GC 81° 40

Thursday
Dec 24th

Commences with Calm Breezy weather employed
getting the Boats the Copper making Rears &c
saw great numbers of Petrels
Middle & Latter part much the same
standing to the NE Lat By CBP 6° 11
Long By GC 82° 20

Friday
Dec 25th

Commences with Light airs from the
Southward & fine pleasant weather.
at 2 PM saw Whale Breaches a great dista-
nce off. Landed 3 Boats in pursuit of them
discovered them to be Humpbacks at 4 PM
the Boats returned to the ship at mid night
tacked to the NW Latter part Light hades
steering NE NW at noon saw the Land Dist
75 miles Lat By CBP 5° 21
Long By GC 81° 25

Saturday
Dec 26th

Commences with fine hades & pleasant weather
steering By the Wind to the Southward Eastward
at 5 PM near the Land tacked to the NW
at night shortened sail.
Middle & Latter Dr standing in for the Land
nothing in sight worthy of notice.
Latitude By CBP 5° 14 P
Long under in 81° 20

Sunday
Dec 27th

Commences with Light hades & fine weather
at 1 PM near the Land tacked to the Westward
at 5 PM tacked to the Eastward again at night
shortened sail.
Middle Dr Latter part Light airs & hazy standing
in for the Land. Lat By CBP 5° 13 P
Dist 8 Leagues from Land

Monday
Dec 28th

Commences with Light Breezes & hazy weather
steering ENE for Payta Head at 5 PM came
to in Payta Harbor in 9 fathoms water with the
small Bower Anchor.
Latter part employed heeling the ship & Black-
ing the Pencils - Payta

Tuesday
Dec 29th

During this day fine weather employed
Painting ship &c.

Wednesday
Dec 30th

During this day fine pleasant weather emp-
loyed painting & Blacking Bends &c.
found the 3 of the People intended to leave
the ship but then in good

Thursday
Dec 31st

Fine pleasant weather employed painting the
ship &c. got off some potatoes
