Commences with light trades & pleasant weather
steering to the SW in company with the
Ship Isaac Howland
Middle & Latter Do. steering By the Wind to the
SW. so ends.

Jan 8th
Commences with Light trades & pleasant weather
at 8 PM parted company with the Isaac Howland
Middle Do - steering West. at 10 AM saw two large
