Commences with moderate trades & fine weather steering P.W. the Blacksmith employed making Timber nails. Middle & Latter Do steering as above - saw Porpoises - Lat By O.B.P. 56°

During these 24 hours Light trades & pleasant weather steering P.W. at 6 A.M. steered N.W. employed getting rigging &c &c - Lat By O.B.P. 32°

During these 24 hours Light trades & fine weather steering W.N.W. employed getting rigging &c - saw porpoises - Latitude By O.B.P. 34°

Commences with Light trades & fine pleasant weather steering W.N.W. Middle Do Latter part Light trades & fine weather at 9 A.M. saw a sail to the N.E. the Blacksmith employed making nails the people employed making sprungams & mats &c &c - Latitude By O.B.P. 56°

During these 24 hours Light trades & pleasant weather steering to the Westward employed getting &c - Latitude By O.B.P. 54°
Longitude By a.C. 121° 20

Friday

12th

During these 24 hours moderate weather employed turning up the main Rigging saw the ship - saw Porpoises - Latitude By O.B.P. 41°
Longitude By a.C. 121° 50

Saturday
March
13th

Commences with Light trades & pleasant weather steering W.N.W. saw Porpoises - employed turning up the Main Rigging - at 7 A.M. saw a school of Spinn Whales - four Boats in pursuit of them struck & killed two small Whales - at noon got them to the ship - Latitude By O.B.P. 35°
Longitude By a.C. 124° 30

Sunday
March
14th

First part moderate trades & pleasant weather at 1 P.M. began cutting - at 3 P.M. finished Do at 6 A.M. began Boiling Latter Do employed as above - Latitude By O.B.P. 32°
